- In the six counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Durham, 102,840 individuals live in food-insecure households.
- **27,010** are children.
- 7,584 seniors live at or below the poverty level.


- Donate money: For every \$1 donated, five meals or \$10 worth of food is provided.

Durham fast facts

- In fiscal year 2017-2018, the Durham Branch distributed a record **9,522,874** pounds of food and partnered with a network of **216** agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, and group homes).
- This equates to more than 8,019,262 meals for those in need.
- Volunteers donated **31,305** hours.
