### The need in the Raleigh Branch service area

- In the 10 counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Raleigh, 255,970 individuals live in food-insecure households.
- **83,900** are children.
- 19,604 seniors live at or below the poverty level.

- Food Distribution (Fresh Produce and Retail Donation)
- Kids Meals & More (Kids Cafe, Weekend Power Pack, Kids Summer Meals, School Pantry)
- Three Squares for CENC (Food & Nutrition Services Outreach)
- Community Health & Engagement

## Raleigh fast facts

- In fiscal year 2017-2018, the Raleigh Branch distributed a record **29,081,122** pounds of food and partnered with a network of **312** agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, and group homes).
- This equates to **24,489,366 meals** for those in need.
- Volunteers donated **51,370** hours.
